## Class Preview for today, April 6:

Solomon in Ecclesiastes Chapter 6 now goes into what appears to be an inner discussion of the meaning of life as it relates to life after death. Once again the Sadduceic vs. Pharisaic debate is reignited. The Sadducees, who were a Jewish sect that denied the resurrection, were often in conflict with the Pharisees, who believed in it. This debate is reflected in the text of Ecclesiastes 6:1-12, where Solomon discusses the futility of life and the uncertainty of the afterlife. The text is a complex of Hebrew idioms and metaphors that have been interpreted in various ways by scholars and theologians alike. The Sadducees' denial of the resurrection is a key point of contention, as it challenges the foundational beliefs of many Jewish and Christian traditions. The Pharisees' belief in the resurrection, on the other hand, is a cornerstone of their faith and a central tenet of their theology. The text of Ecclesiastes 6:1-12 is a rich and challenging passage that invites us to reflect on the meaning of life and the hope of the afterlife.
